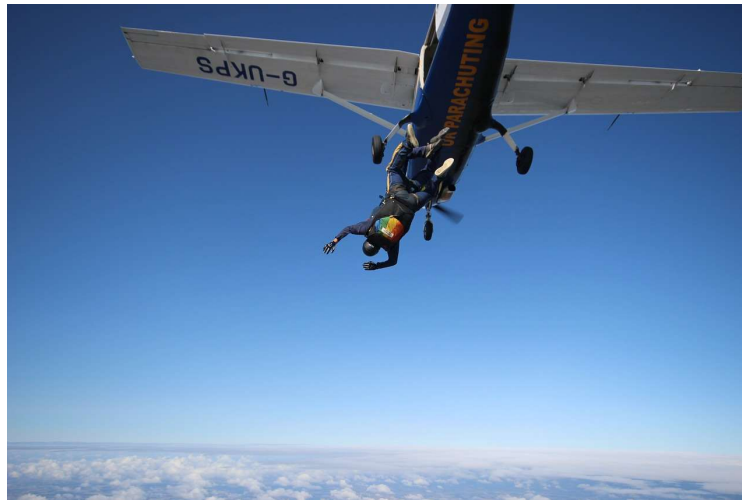


PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE

He has **just** jumped off a plane.

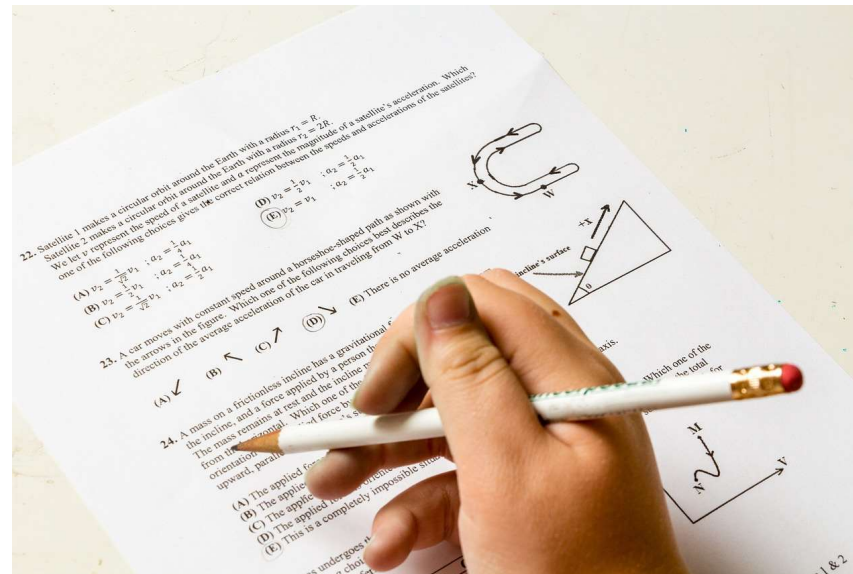
ALREADY – EARLIER THAN THE TIME EXPECTED
